

## VIMBISO SCHOLARSHIP TRUST FUND

### Application Process

#### Step 1: Submission of Application

Interested applicants must complete the Vimbiso Scholarship Application Form and submit it together with all required supporting documents before the stipulated deadline.

#### Step 2: Preliminary Screening

Applications will be reviewed to ensure that:

- The application form has been fully completed.
- All required supporting documents have been submitted.
- The applicant meets the minimum eligibility requirements.

Incomplete applications may not be considered.

#### Step 3: Evaluation of Applications

Eligible applications will be assessed based on:

- Academic performance and potential.
- Financial need.
- Motivation to pursue the Chartered Accountancy qualification.
- Leadership qualities and community involvement.
- Referee recommendations.

#### Step 4: Interviews

Shortlisted applicants may be invited to attend an interview with the Vimbiso Selection Committee. The interview will assess the applicant's suitability, commitment, and potential to benefit from the programme.

#### Step 5: Verification

The Selection Committee may verify information provided in the application, including academic records, financial circumstances, and referee details.

#### Step 6: Selection and Approval

Following the evaluation process, the Selection Committee will make recommendations for approval based on the available scholarship spaces and funding.

#### Step 7: Communication of Results

Successful and unsuccessful applicants will be notified of the outcome of their applications through the contact details provided in the application form.

#### Step 8: Acceptance of Scholarship

Successful applicants will be required to formally accept the scholarship and comply with the terms and conditions of the Vimbiso Scholarship Programme.

#### Step 9: Onboarding into the Vimbiso Programme

Successful applicants will attend an orientation session where they will be introduced to the programme, expectations, mentorship opportunities, and scholarship requirements.

#### Required Supporting Documents

Applicants must submit:

- Certified copy of National ID or Birth Certificate.
- Certified academic results.
- Proof of residence.
- Recommendation letter.
- Any other documents requested by the Selection Committee.
