



Membership Card Services

The ICAZ membership card is available for all members as a form of identification. It is available in physical and in digital format. For local members the cards can be collected from ICAZ offices and for non-resident the cards will be sent to your chapter representative after the Covid 19 restrictions have been relaxed.

You may access your digital membership card on the MyICAZ app which is freely available on Apple store and Google Play store.

The membership card can also be used to access certain privileges and discounts with selected providers. As an ICAZ Member the following are the current list of services you can access at a discount using your card:

- 10% discount on all cash purchases of US\$100 or more at Truworths Clothing
- 10% discount at Connections Café located at Celebration Centre in Borrowdale
- Priority Pass for access to airport lounges under the ICAZ scheme price. As the travel restrictions begin to ease your Institute would like to remind you of your Priority Pass (an airport lounges provider) benefit as an ICAZ Member, for your travel convenience.
