RE: NOMINATIONS: ELECTIONS TO COUNCIL: 2017

1. Nominations are invited for election to the vacancies listed in paragraph 2.0 below.

1.1 **Mashonaland**

In terms of section 3 of the *Chartered Accountants By-laws, 1997*, Messrs D. Marange, W. Mupanguri and Mrs. D. Shinya will retire immediately before the conclusion of the Annual General Meeting which, this year is expected to be held at 1700hrs on Thursday 20 July 2017 at Victoria Falls. Mr. D. Marange has indicated that he will not be standing for re-election. Mr. W. Mupanguri and Mrs. D. Shinya, both being eligible, have offered themselves for re-election.

1.2 **Matabeleland**

In terms of section 3 of the *Chartered Accountants By-laws, 1997*, Mr. G. Neely and Mrs. B. Munyurwa will retire immediately before the conclusion of the Annual General Meeting. Both have indicated that they will not be standing for re-election.

1.3 **Midlands**

In terms of section 3 (5) of the *Chartered Accountants By-laws, 1997*, Mr. A. Zvandasara will retire immediately before the conclusion of the Annual General Meeting and has offered himself for re-election.

1.4 **Diaspora Chapter**

In response to diaspora members' request to increase representation for the diaspora members on Council, one vacancy from Mashonaland will be surrendered to the Diaspora Chapter. A call is therefore being made for nominations from the diaspora (new vacancy).

2.0 Vacancies

The number of vacancies is therefore as follows -

3.0 Nominations may be made for any of the above vacancies by conforming to the requirements below.

3.1 Candidates must be nominated by at least three members of the Institute **who are in good standing (subscriptions and CPD hours up-to-date)**.

The nomination must be in writing and must be signed by all three of the nominators. It must also indicate the area in which the candidate is normally resident and which he would represent if elected.

The nominators need not be resident in the same area.

3.2 The candidate must indicate, in writing, willingness to represent the area in which he/she resides.
